Rockdale County Water Resources Service Line Inspection Program

In accordance with EPA and Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) guidelines, Rockdale County Water Resources (RWR) is taking steps to evaluate the composition of service lines:

1. Routine inspections

- RWR technicians are examining and logging water service line materials as part of daily operations.

2. Targeted service line excavations

- Contractors will dig small test holes at selected properties to verify pipe materials directly in the field

3. Customer-driven material identification

- Customers can identify their own service line material and report it online. Visit the “Lead and Copper Status” section on the Rockdale County Water Resources website to look up your address and participate in the material-reporting survey
